Pre-Kindergarten Students:

- Must be **four** years old **on or before** Sept. 1, 2017.

****The following documents will be needed to register:**

- Certified copy of the child's birth certificate
- Complete, up-to-date immunization record
- Student's social security card
- Proof of residence (utility bill, copy of lease, tax statement)
- Parent or Guardian picture ID

****Proof of Income is required to establish eligibility (Please see below.)**

Kindergarten Students:

- KG students **MUST** be **five** years old **on or before** Sept. 1, 2017.

****The following documents will be needed to register:**

- Certified copy of the child's birth certificate
- Complete, up-to-date immunization record
- Student's social security card
- Proof of residence (utility bill, copy of lease, tax statement)
- Parent or Guardian picture ID

PRE-KINDERGARTEN FAMILIES MUST MEET ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA LISTED BELOW,

- The child is unable to speak and comprehend the English language,
 - *A home Language Survey must be completed and a time will be scheduled to test the student's English proficiency.
- The child is educationally disadvantaged
 - *Must provide current paycheck stub(s)
 - *Notice of Food Stamp Eligibility and food stamp case number
 - *Temporary assistance to Needy Families (TANF) Benefit Letter
- The child is homeless, as defined by 42 U.S.C Section 11302
- The child has a parent or official guardian that is an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority.
 - *Department of Defense identification required
- The child has a parent or official guardian that is a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty.
- The child has ever been in the foster care of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS)
 - *Letter from the Department of Family and Protective Services required.
