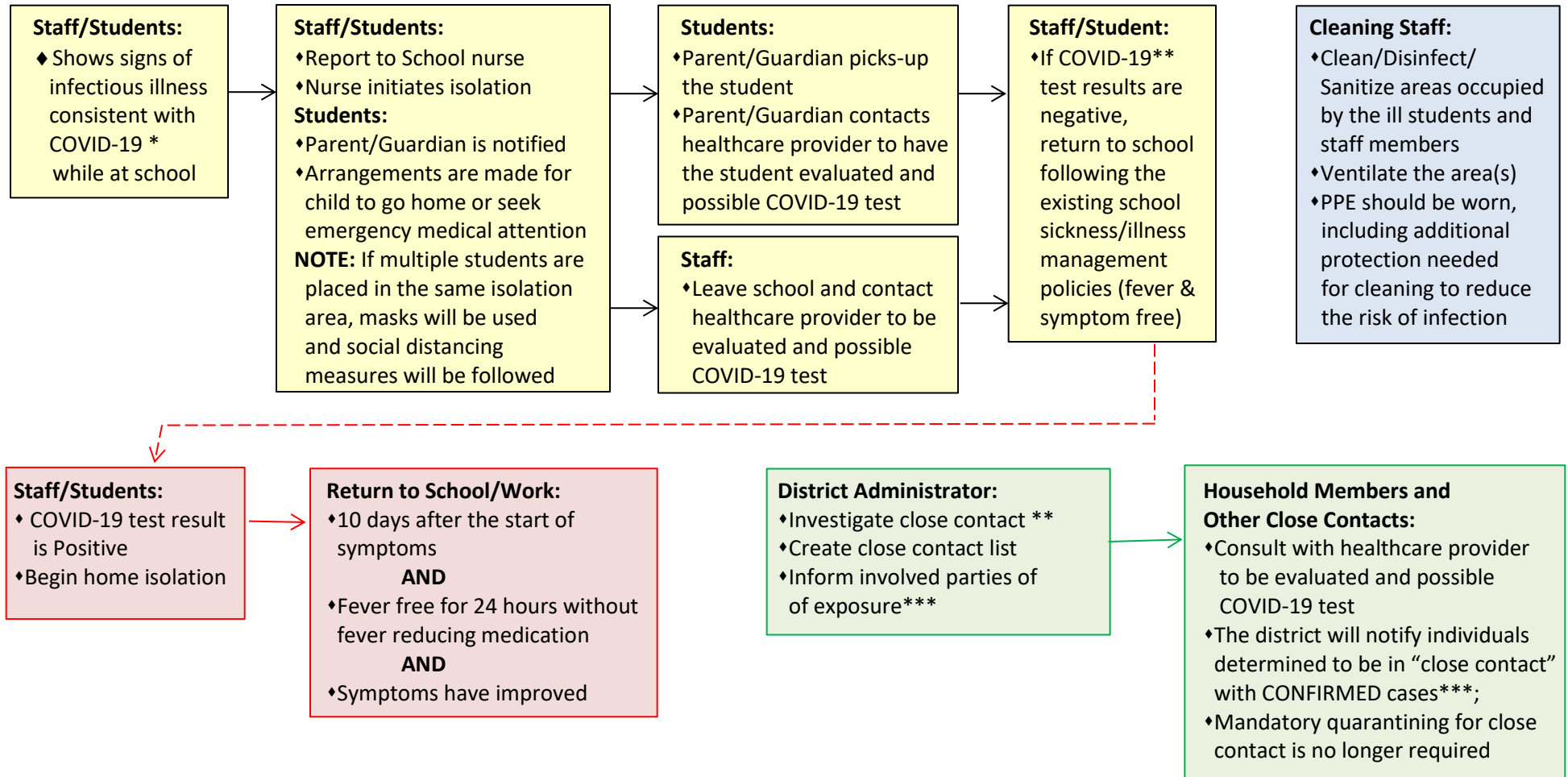




WHAT TO DO IF STUDENT/STAFF BECOMES SICK OR REPORTS A COVID-19 DIAGNOSIS



As the Texas Legislature did not approve funding for remote learning, students who must isolate due to confirmed COVID or who choose to quarantine for close contact will be considered “absent” from school and must comply with District procedures for missed instruction and make-up work. While considered excused absences, state compulsory attendance guidelines must be met for credit and grade-level promotion.

*The most common symptoms of COVID-19 include fever or chills, cough, nasal congestion or runny nose, new loss of taste or smell, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, diarrhea or vomiting, stomachache, tiredness, headache, muscle or body ache, and poor appetite.

**Close contact is defined as someone who was within 3 feet for a total of 15 minutes or more within 2 days prior to illness onset

***To the extent allowable by applicable laws regarding privacy.
